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

# Signet's SRSP and DRSP aligned with international standards

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- The Signet Responsible Sourcing Protocol (SRSP) and R2Net Diamonds Responsible Sourcing Protocol (DRSP) are based on OECD's Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Sourcing which requires companies to follow a 5-step framework.
- The OECD framework requires a clear company policy, system of controls, supply chain due diligence, risk assessment, reporting and independent 3rd party audit.
- International “conflict minerals” legislation (in USA and EU) is based on OECD guidance.
- OECD framework is also integral to the Responsible Jewellery Council's Code of Practices and its certification system.
- The SRSP and DRSP requires all Signet suppliers to follow the OECD guidance.
- Reference Section 2 of the DRSP of the R2Net DRSP for guidance on conducting due diligence on your supply chain.

# Compliance with SRSP and DRSP – a Guideline

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SRSP and DRSP compliance criteria and requirements, include but are not limited to:

Conduct Due Diligence

- **Map your supply chains.** For metals (gold, 3Ts, silver, platinum), identify and certify the sources of your metals, preferably to a refinery. For diamonds and gemstones, list your suppliers, categorize the sources and list all identified entities in the supply chain.

Company Policies and Procedures

- **Establish appropriate company policies** (e.g., compliance with KP, Conflict Minerals). Establish and implement procedures which ensure the sourcing of your products do not contribute to human rights abuses. Establish Management Systems, a Know Your Counterparty ("KYC") policy and Terms of Business with all your suppliers. Conduct testing of diamonds and LGDs.

Documents and Evidence

- **Maintain information and documentation** of your due diligence, invoices, delivery notes, certifications, which may be required should you be asked to undergo an independent third party audit.

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# Diamonds: the Kimberley Process and WDC System of Warranties

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- Signet does not tolerate the use of diamonds to fund conflict and is a strong supporter of the Kimberley Process (KP) and the associated World Diamond Council System of Warranties.
- The KP is a global certification system in the trade of rough diamonds between participating countries which prevents “conflict diamonds” from entering the legitimate diamond supply chain.
- The WDC System of Warranties is a monitoring process at all points in the diamond supply chain which companies use to provide assurance of the integrity of the diamonds they trade.
- All the diamonds Signet buys are warrantied to be sourced from KP compliant countries, and all Signet suppliers must provide the WDC warranty statement with all diamonds supplied to Signet.

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# 2021 Warranty Statements for all DMarket suppliers

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- Following reporting compliance to the DRSP, all suppliers are required to include the DRSP and diamond warranty statement on all invoices and delivery notes to R2Net and Signet.

DRSP:

*“The seller warrants that these products have been supplied in compliance with the R2Net Diamonds Responsible Sourcing Protocol (‘DRSP’).”*

WDC SoW:

*“Any natural diamonds herein supplied have been purchased from legitimate sources not involved in funding conflict and in compliance with United Nations Resolutions and corresponding national laws. The seller hereby guarantees that these natural diamonds are conflict-free and confirms adherence to the WDC SOW Guidelines.”*

For LGDs  
only:

*“Any laboratory-grown diamonds herein supplied comply with the DRSP and are warranted not to include any natural diamonds or any material which is not laboratory-grown diamond. ”*

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# Testing for Undisclosed Lab-Grown Diamonds

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- Suppliers must take substantive and documented action to avoid the inclusion of undisclosed laboratory-grown/laboratory-created diamonds (LGDs), undisclosed treated diamonds or undisclosed diamond simulants in parcels of natural diamonds provided to R2Net.
- Conduct an internal pipeline risk assessment, identifying all possible points at which undisclosed LGDs, undisclosed treated diamonds or undisclosed diamond simulants could enter the Suppliers' natural diamond supply chain.
- Policies, procedures and training must pay special attention to these risk points and mitigate the risks appropriately.

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# Testing for Undisclosed Lab-Grown Diamonds

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- Testing must be implemented on the following bases:
  - Loose polished natural diamonds - 100% of your loose polished natural diamonds must be tested prior to the diamonds being moved into a production environment or set into jewelry. The tested natural diamonds must be sealed immediately following testing, and the sealed natural diamonds carefully secured throughout the jewelry manufacturing process.
  - Finished jewelry – Suppliers should work towards 100% testing. Where this is not possible, suppliers should screen using the De Beers BPP Disclosure Practice Note 2018 as guidance. Suppliers must be able to evidence they are working towards 100% screening of finished jewelry.
  - Suppliers must be able to demonstrate and evidence that 100% loose natural diamonds are tested and the percentage of set natural diamonds tested and maintain relevant documentation.
  - Supplier testing must be conducted with the use of the best available detection technology and fully trained staff, or testing may be outsourced to a qualified and accredited gemological testing laboratory.

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# DRSP Natural Diamond Categories

- Suppliers must identify all diamonds supplied to Signet within each or any of these 4 categories:

Category 1 Single Stone Tracking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Individual diamonds supplied by or sourced from identified diamond producers which are independently certified under separate, relevant international standards (such as the RJC Code of Practices).</li></ul>
Category 2 Parcel Tracking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Parcels of diamonds supplied by or sourced from identified diamond producers which are independently certified under separate, relevant international standards (such as the RJC Code of Practices).</li></ul>
Category 3 Mixed Sources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>This category allows for the mixing of diamonds deriving from a number of different sources, with some percentage of the diamonds deriving from identified and verified sources.</li></ul>
Category 4 Other Identified & Verified Sources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>This category applies to diamonds which derive from small-scale or artisanal producers.</li></ul>

• Documentation of your due diligence: invoices, delivery notes, and certifications, will be required should you be asked to undergo an independent third-party audit.



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## My Reports – Timing and Process

### 2021 DRSP Report

- All Signet R2Net suppliers will be notified by email in October to complete the DRSP compliance report, available at [signetresponsiblesourcing.com](https://signetresponsiblesourcing.com)
- A DRSP compliance report must be completed when onboarded to the DMarket platform and annually to meet Signet's due diligence and legal requirements
- Online Reports should be completed by November 30, 2021
- A 2021 DRSP Confirmation number will be issued upon completion and approval of the report.

### Environmental & Social Report (E & S Report)

- New for 2021 - All Signet suppliers will complete the E&S Report at [signetresponsiblesourcing.com](https://signetresponsiblesourcing.com)
- Under “My Reports,” select “E&S Report”
- The E&S Report should also be completed by November 30, 2021
- An E&S Report Confirmation number will be issued for completed reports, similar to the DRSP Confirmation number

- Once logged in:

Signet Jewelers believes a responsible, conflict-free supply chain is fundamental to the reputation of the jewelry industry and its future. Signet is a founding and certified member of the Responsible Jewellery Council (RJC). RJC membership and subsequent certification requires Signet of our suppliers' responsible sourcing practices and therefore requires all its suppliers who sell gold, platinum, silver, natural diamonds, and colored gemstones to be members of the RJC.

All suppliers to Signet are required to undertake due diligence on their own supply chains in accordance with the OECD's Due Diligence Guidance 5-step framework to ensure that the metals and/or minerals they supply are responsibly managed, and are 'conflict-free' and sourced with respect for human rights.

Please reference Section 3 of the Signet Responsible Sourcing Protocol (SRSP) for specific supplier requirements relative to supply chain due diligence.

Signet has produced global guidance for all suppliers called the Signet Responsible Sourcing Protocol (SRSP), which is aligned with international guidance and standards, and identifies compliance criteria to ensure Signet's supply chain is responsibly sourced.

The SRSP outlines the procedures that Signet suppliers must follow to ensure supplies of all products, or services using, gold, tin, tungsten, tantalum (3Ts), natural diamonds, silver, platinum group metals (PGMs), colored gemstones (natural emerald, ruby, and/or sapphire), and lab grown diamonds (LGDs) are responsibly sourced.

All suppliers to Signet are required to complete the annual SRSP report. If you supply ONLY natural or lab grown loose or polished diamonds, or colored gemstones, you are required to complete the SRSP Report.

Please ensure the person completing the report on behalf of your company is familiar with the SRSP, and especially the compliance criteria listed in the appendices.


